Student Leadership Opportunities

Sigma Tau Delta offers student leadership opportunities at the regional and international level for students to be part in the management of the Society. Applications are open for Student Advisor (SA), Student Representatives (SR), and Student Associate Representatives (ASR).

The last day to apply is March 31st.

Here's an overview of each leadership opportunity:

Student Advisor

Term: Serves for two years [April 2021-March 2023]

Roll: Provide the student voice as voting members of the Board of Directors, serve as co-chair of the Student Leadership Committee, serve on the Communications Committee and serve the Board by being a member of committees as needed.

Student Representative

Term: One-year term [April 2021-March 2022]

Roll: Regional duties include soliciting input from members in the region regarding Society policies and activities, contribute to Society communications, participate in official regional and Student Leadership Committee communications and delegate duties to the region's Associate Student Representative among other duties.

Board, and Convention Duties include attending all necessary Board and committee meetings, aid in the development of implementation of the Student Leadership Workshop, moderate regional meeting and activities among other duties found [here](#).

Associate Student Representative

Term: One-year term [April 2021-March 2022]

Roll: Will assist the Student Representative in regional duties, advise the Student Leadership Committee on annual report of activities to the Board, serve on leadership committee and other boards as appointed and assist with convention duties.
